SRA APPOINTS KEIKO KIMURA AS SECRETARIAT MANAGER

Wednesday, 20 June 2018 – The Singapore Reinsurers' Association (SRA) has boosted its Secretariat team with the appointment of Ms Keiko Kimura as Secretariat Manager with effect from 9 April 2018. In this newly-created role, Keiko will support the Executive Director in overseeing the day-to-day operations of the Secretariat, with particular focus on the organisation of the annual Singapore International Reinsurance Conference (SIRC), for which the SRA is the main organiser. Commenting on the appointment, SRA Chairman Mr Marc Haushofer said, "With the SIRC going annual and with the SRA shouldering most of the responsibility for managing the Conference Secretariat, it was imperative that we bolster the SRA Secretariat team. In this regard, we are pleased to welcome Keiko and believe that she will be able to make significant contributions with her event management experience and background in the hospitality industry".
